The mom never looked back... even though she is seen at times only a few blocks away, begging and high on drugs. We were able to intervene and it is a blessing for us to be able to help these little girls with a lot of love and a wonderful place to live. Our ladies washed all the dirt from their frail bodies and fixed their hair, put new pretty clothes on them, and hugged and kissed them! Usually now, the 2 bigger girls are the ones that run to greet visitors and you can see the peace and joy on their faces.

Edgar, 16, just received an honors award for being # 1 in his whole school for all three years! There will be a special government ceremony for this! Edgar 5 years ago was begging on the streets, singing on buses, being molested, and living on the street. God has done great things with this young man!! Many of our other children have received recognition for being the top of their class too!

We now have 80 children of the worst situations that one can imagine. Brothers and sisters of one family of a drug addict came to us with scars over their faces.

Giovanni, 16, came to us having shuffled from agency to agency for years. It appears that no one really took the time to hug him and cry with him over the death of his mother when he was 5 years old. He

is a teddy bear... so kind and caring. Now he has us for family and home until he finishes college if he desires!

Some of our older kids made a large amount of food on their own and went into the streets to share the Lord and to feed the hungry. This is their own project without any adult help! This is what we are about! Kids on their own ministering to others!

Because we are growing with more needy children and these children are growing in the Lord, we continue to need your help. Summer is here, and with vacation time, people forget

that we are still with the kids all summer and we are in need of continual help. We appreciate you soooo... much! You are an integral part of us.

We could use volunteers that will do whatever is needed – dentists, someone who can hook up a dental chair, and Spanish- speaking psychologist. We always need funding: electricity, propane, transportation, medical, dental, food, and paying the workers. The cost for each child

is less than \$10 per day, or with 80 children, is coming close to \$20,000 a month. We need your help!
